

Who Am I in Christ?

Without the gospel of Jesus Christ, your “self” is fragile—it must be defended, curated, and proven, as if your value were tied to your integrity or track record. But the good news of the gospel is that Jesus unites us to Himself through faith in His life, death, and resurrection—and thereby gives us a new identity in Him that cannot be shaken. It means your righteousness is now imputed, not earned. You don't have to be anyone to be loved; you are already a child of the King—fully accepted with nothing to prove. For the lonely, Christ is in you and will never leave you. For the addict, Christ is your friend and has set you free from sin. For the victim, Christ—who is working all things for good—is near, and you have direct access to him. Knowing who we truly are in Christ strengthens you in the midst of weakness.
